

SECTION V - REACTIVITY DATA

IS THE PRODUCT STABLE: Stable
INCOMPATIBLE SUBSTANCES: Strong acids and oxidizers.
CONDITIONS OF REACTIVITY: None
HAZARDOUS DECOMPOSITION PRODUCTS: Thermal decomposition may produce oxides of carbon.

SECTION VI - TOXICOLOGICAL PROPERTIES

PRIMARY ROUTES OF EXPOSURE: Skin and eye contact and inhalation. Ingestion is unlikely.
EXPOSURE LIMITS: Not established for this product.
WHMIS CLASSIFICATION: D2B – Other Toxic Effects. Skin and eye irritant.
INGREDIENTS SUSPECTED TO BE CARCINOGENIC: None - IARC / OSHA / NTP
MUTAGEN: Not a mutagen. **REPRODUCTIVE EFFECTS:** None known.
SYNERGISTIC PRODUCTS: None known.
EFFECTS OF ACUTE EXPOSURE: **EYES:** Corrosive. Severe irritation, redness and tearing. May cause irreversible damage. **SKIN:** Irritation, chapping with prolonged or repeated exposure.
INGESTION: May be harmful if swallowed. Gastrointestinal irritation, nausea, vomiting and diarrhea.
INHALATION: Irritation to upper respiratory tract.
EFFECTS OF CHRONIC EXPOSURE: Irritation and chapping with prolonged or repeated skin exposure.
